## About sponsored membership

Sponsored membership means that sedimentologists with less financial resources can get free membership for a year through the Friendship Scheme. In this scheme, other IAS members can opt to pay a part of a membership fee (as the Friendship Scheme option when paying for membership); IAS then pays the other part. Applicants need to provide a short but relevant motivation stating why they would benefit from sponsored membership.
