GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The General Assembly of the Association will meet in Jerusalem on Monday July 10th. Members are reminded that, according to the Statutes, the General Assembly "votes on important issues of the Association". In particular elections will take place for the posts of President, Vice-Presidents, General Secretary, Treasurer, Editor, Publications Secretary and six other members of Council. In addition the place of the next Congress will be decided.

Of the present officers, the General Secretary, the Editors and the Publications Secretary have all stated that they do not wish to be nominated for re-election. The Treasurer has resigned since the last Congress and Dr. D.J. Nio has been appointed Acting Treasurer by the President forthe remainder of the present period. He has said that he is willing to be nominated for the post of Treasurer.

The Bureau is required by the Statutes to act as a Nominating Committee by preparing a list of nominations for Council who will propose a list for the Assembly to vote upon. However members of the Association may individually make proposals, provided their names reach the General Secretary at least one month before the Assembly (by June 10th) or if submitted at the Assembly the proposal has at least 50 signatures of members.

Invitations for hosting the next Congress may still be sent to the General Secretary. They have to reach him 3 months before the General Assembly (by April 10th).

The Bureau intends to propose one relatively small change in the Statutes to take into account the pattern of editorship as it has evolved over the past few years. This is to replace the existing elected 'Editor' and appointed 'Associate Editor' by two 'Editors' elected at the General Assembly. These changes will be put before the General Assembly.

The Bureau will also propose an increase in Dues for 1979 from Dfl. 40 to Dfl.50 and from Dfl.24 to Dfl.30 for those under 26 years of age. It is true that the present financial situation is good. However the annual surplus is decreasing each year and since the dues can only be raised at a meeting of the General Assembly it is thought wiser to make an increase next year rather than allow the Association to go into deficit before the next opportunity to raise dues is offered, which would be in 1983.

Members are reminded that in 1968 annual dues were Dfl. 68.50 with no reduction for younger members for a journal 1 the size of the present one. The present rates were introduced in 1973.

Help for members under 26 years of age to attend Israel Congress

Financial assistance will be given to those under 26 years of age who have been members in 1977 and 1978 to attend the Israel Congress. A limited sum has been set aside for this and will be given at a rate of US \$50 for those not reading a paper and US \$75 for those reading a paper. The money will be available from the Treasurer at the Congress. Applications should be sent to the Treasurer as soon as possible. The closing date for application is June 1st.
