

THIRD SYMPOSIUM OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN DIVISION OF SEDIMENTOLOGISTS

The Third Symposium of the South African Division of Sedimentologists is to be held in September 1982 in Johannesburg. The symposium will have as its theme applied sedimentology, because of the overwhelming importance of the discipline in the exploration for and exploitation of ore deposits in Southern Africa.

The symposium is entitled "SEDIMENTOLOGY APPLIED TO EXPLORATION, MINING, ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES" and will include the sedimentological aspects of placer deposits, epigenetic uranium deposits, stratiform and stratabound sulphide and gold deposits, carbonates and lead-zinc mineralisation, coal, petroleum, iron, manganese, clay and bauxite deposits, engineering and environmental sedimentology.

PROGRAMME

The symposium will extend over three days and will be followed by an excursion lasting four days. The sedimentary rocks to be examined on the excursion will be the Proterozoic Transvaal Supergroup carbonates and iron formations exposed in the Griqualand West area of the Northern Cape.

VENUE: Rand Afrikaans University, Johannesburg

<u>DATES</u>: Symposium 13-15 September 1982 Excursion 16-19 September 1982

REGISTRATION: The registration fee will be nominal

ACCOMODATION: Persons wishing to attend the symposium should make their own arrangements for accomodation. Lunches and teas will be provided.

SUBMISSION OF PAPERS :

All persons working on economic, engineering or environmental sedimentology are invited to present papers at the symposium. The emphasis should preferably be on sedimentary modelling. Short abstracts of not more than one hundred words should reach the organizing committee by January 31st, 1982, extended abstracts by June 30th, 1982, and drafts for publication on the opening day of the symposium.

FOURTH I.A.S. EUROPEAN MEETING

The Fourth I.A.S. European Meeting will take place in Yugoslavia/Split, Croatia, late in April or early in May, 1983.

The programme will be as follows :

- Three days of plenary sessions (contributions welcome);
- Panels will be available for displaying posters;

- Short field trips (two days) are planned before and after the main sessions. The subjects will include:
 - Tidal flat, lagoonal and shallow marine carbonate sediments (Upper Jurassic and Cretaceous, Istria);
 - Upper Cretaceous carbonate platform depositional environments, their relation with asphalt and bitumen occurrences (Dalmatian's islands);
 - 3) Paleogene clastic facies in northern Dalmatia (Flysch and "Promina" beds) : channels, massive beds, large exotic blocks, carbonate turbidites, conglomerate horizons.


