ISC 94 GOES TO BRAZIL

It was decided at the ISC 90 General Assembly at Nottingham that the membership should be consulted by ballots on the venue of the International Sedimentological Congress in 1994.

The decision of the bureau would be made when the advice of the membership was received. The membership voted by a large majority (2:1) to hold the 1994 congress in Brazil. The bureau followed the advice and decided that the ISC 94 will be held at the University of Pernambuco in Brazil.

I will use this opportunity on behalf of the bureau to express our warmest thanks for the two invitations received. A very considerable amount of work has been put into the preparations and invitations and we hope some of this work can be used in the planning of Thematic Meetings or Field Workshops in the future.

REPORT FROM SWITZERLAND

In 1990, the group of Swiss sedimentologists SWISS SED organized two field meetings.

A two-day trip into the Urgonian facies of the Helvetic nappes was guided by Benno Schwizer, Tina Schenk and Martin Ziegler. Main topics were the ecology of these shallow-water carbonates and the complex stacking pattern of shallowing-upward sequences.

A one-day excursion, together with the Swiss Geological Society, concentrated on facies evolution and diagenesis of Kimmeridgian reefs in the French Jura. Guides were Eric Davaud and Eric Fookes.

For 1991, field meetings are planned which will focus on depositional environments and sequence stratigraphy in the Molasse (by Alain Lejay), and on Kimmeridgian sedimentary cycles in the Swiss Jura (by Christian Meyer).

A workshop on contourites will be held from April 15 to 19 in Fribourg. Invited lectures are D.A.V. Stow and J.-C. Faugères.

For next October, a twelve-day workshop on comparative sedimentology in southern Tunisia is being organized by Eric Davaud, Ali M'Rabet and André Strasser. Invited lectures include Paul Wright and Judy McKenzie.

GENERAL NEWS

SYMPOSIUM ON SUBGLACIAL PROCESSES, SEDIMENTS AND LANDFORMS

JULY 3-5, 1992 - ULSTER, NORTHERN IRELAND

The symposium, a follow-up to the Third International Drumlin Symposium in Finland, will be held at the University of Ulster, Colrain, Northern Ireland from 3-5 July 1992. The symposium will focus on relationships between glacier dynamics, subglacial processes, sediments and landforms, and genetic relationships between subglacial and ice-marginal (terrestrial and marine) environments.

A five day field excursion will be held from 6-10 July 1992. The field excursion will be based mainly on the western seaboard of Ireland and will examine drumlin sedimentology in Donegal Bay; shelly diamictons and glaciomarine deltas in north Mayo; drumlin sedimentology in Clew Bay; late Pleistocene shallow marine debris fans and raised inter-tidal sequences, Achill Island; glaciomarine deltas and ice-pushed ridges in the Erriff Valley; water-escape and related structures in drumlins, Rinvyle Point; drumlin sedimentology in Galway Bay and glacial/glaciomarine debris fans, Cahir Valley (Burren).

Intending participants are invited to submit abstracts on any topic relevant to the Symposium theme. Oral and poster presentation are encouraged and carry equal weighting. Oral presentations will generally be 15 minutes long, with 5 minutes for discussion. Abstracts should not exceed 150 words and must be typed on one sheet of paper, with single spacing and wide margins. It is intended that the proceedings will be published at the commencement of the Symposium or shortly after.

Details of costs and other arrangements will be included in the next circular, which will be circulated in August 1991.
